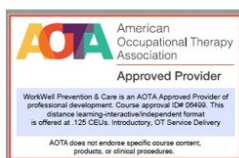

Much of the value of onsite services is found outside the clinic walls, assessing/engaging with workers in their work area/s and working on practical interventions to help prevent injury and restore function. This course provides an overview of common job site services such as job coaching, worksite rounding, education, microbreaks/warm ups, and related worker/stakeholder communication.

Learning Objectives:

1. Develop a movement strategy plan based on case information, with 2 different movement strategies appropriately identified
2. Outline 2 appropriate adult educational strategies relevant to an onsite case scenario
3. Develop an onsite services plan with 2 different interventions based on case information, appropriately using elements of job coaching and communication.
4. Describe 2 ways workplace rounding facilitates scheduled and situational worker engagement during the provision of onsite services.
